Activity 1

Reviewing Finger Patterns

Using 5 frame cards in a pocket chart, play a silent guessing game about which card will come next, placing cards sequentially.

Activity 2

Flash and Show

Do a faster-paced version of flash and show in which students show the number first with one hand and then with the other.

Activity 3

Bunny Ears Make Five

Using the 5-frames with blue and red dots, teacher displays a card. Students discuss what they notice. Then students show that way of making 5 with their fingers on their heads like bunny ears.
