Activity I
Introducing the Five-Frames
Introduce the five-frame cards and show how to use finger patterns to count the squares in the frame
Activity 2
Flash and Show

Flash a five-frame card, hide the card, students show with their fingers how many dots, reveal the card, and then count the dots

## Activity 3

Flash and Build
Played liked flash and show except student use unifix cubes on their own five-frame to show how many dots are on the card. Students use a different color cube to fill in the remaining spaces on the frame and count to prove that it is 5
